

2021 ICPA Scholarship Opportunity For Engineering and Construction Management Students

The Iowa Concrete Paving Association (ICPA) is pleased to announce its 2021 Scholarship Program for assisting the future development of the highway construction industry in Iowa by providing scholarships to Civil and Construction Engineering and/or Construction Management students at Iowa State University (ISU), the University of Iowa (U of I), and the University of Northern Iowa (UNI).

- 1. The amount and number of scholarship awards is determined annually by the Executive Committee of the Iowa Concrete Paving Association. In 2020, the association awarded eight scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500.
- 2. Awards will be open to students with a sophomore status or higher (as of 11/30/20) majoring in Civil or Construction Engineering at ISU and U of I, and Construction Management at UNI.
- 3. Selection of the scholarship recipient(s) will be made by the Executive Committee of the Iowa Concrete Paving Association. Applicants who are immediate relatives of this committee and students who have previously received an ICPA Scholarship are not eligible for an award.
- 4. Selection of the scholarship recipient(s) will be based on scholarship need, civil or construction engineering experience, an intent to enter the construction field in Iowa, and other criteria. Preference will be given to residents of Iowa and the adjoining states.
- 5. Scholarship recipient(s) will be recognized at the ICPA Annual Concrete Paving Workshop Awards Banquet to be held in February 2021.

Scholarship applications may be downloaded from <u>concretestate.org</u>. Eligible applicants should submit the ICPA scholarship application and an approximate 1,000 word essay outlining goals, objectives, and insight as to why the applicant is considering employment in the concrete paving industry, and/or other related fields such as construction or engineering. Completed applications may be mailed or emailed to the ICPA office no later than November 30, 2020.
