- Student must be pursuing a degree in an area of study that would benefit his or her preparedness for a potential career in the ready mixed concrete or construction/engineering industries.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY (IRMCA Members):

- Student must be enrolled at an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher learning in Iowa, pursuing a
 degree in any area of study.
- Student shall have attained sophomore status or higher (as of November 30, 2020).
- Student with immediate family working for an IRMCA Member.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the IRMCA Scholarship/Educational Outreach Committee. The awards will be based on the applicant's demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, area of study as it relates to the industry, and other achievements and activities.
- While all eligible students will be considered for award, the Iowa Ready Mixed Concrete Association reserves the right to give preference to applicants who are:
 - Residents of the state of Iowa
 - Planning to live and work in Iowa after college
 - Related to an employee of an IRMCA member company
 - Experienced in the ready mixed concrete industry
- Scholarship recipients will be notified in December and invited to attend the IRMCA Annual Convention in March 2021.

Eligible applicants should submit the *IRMCA Scholarship* application and an approximate 1,000 word essay outlining career goals, objectives, and insight as to why applicant is considering employment in the ready mixed concrete industry, and/or other related fields such as construction or engineering.
